- The Statement of Liability for 2022 financial year can be obtained from Revenue or through your mygovid account. If you do not have an account, it is easy to set one up at www.mygovid.ie
- The Statement of Social Protection payment for 2022 can be obtained from the Department of Social Protection or through your mygovid.ie account.
- All documents should be in JPEG, PDF, DOC or DOCX format.
- The Cothrom na Féinne scholarship is not counted as reckonable income by SUSI.
