## **Prescription lenses safety glasses:**

For researchers who require prescription lenses, standard prescription lenses are <u>not</u> suitable as safety glasses. Similarly, the inherent risks involved in wearing contact lenses means researchers are not permitted to wear them in the lab.

Over-glasses are available from Chemistry Stores which fit over most prescription glasses.

Prescription safety glasses are a good option for most researchers who require prescription lenses. They are available from Specsavers.
