



Centre for behaviour and health launched at UCD

The Centre for Behaviour and Health at the UCD Geary Institute has been launched. This new research initiative is led by Prof Colm Harmon, Director of the Geary Institute, and Prof Patrick Wall of the UCD School of Public Health and Population Science.

The Centre will focus on four areas of research: health/health behaviour; higher education; financial decision making; and ageing research.

The Centre's work agenda blends the skills of economics, psychology, social statistics, and public health.

The Centre is undertaking research projects including:

- Survey of Health Ageing and Retirement in Europe (SHARE);
- UCD Health Risk Behaviour Study;
- Perceptions of Mental Health Among Young Irish Men.
