Cannabis Class

<u>Δ⁹ Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)</u>:

Cannabis products are derived from the plant Cannabis Sativa and Cannabis Indica or hybrids of these two varieties. Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol is the main psychoactive drug in Cannabis. Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol may only be detectable in blood for 1-2 hours after use although it psychoactive effects can persist for many more hours after use. The legal limit for Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol is 1ng/ml in blood.

11-Nor-9-Carboxy- Δ⁹ Tetrahydrocannabinol (THCA):

This is the main metabolite of Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol (see above) which is quickly formed after consuming Cannabis and is a marker of recent use. It is not known to be pharmacologically active. 11-Nor-9-Carboxy- Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol is detectable for a longer period than the parent drug. The legal limit for 11-nor-9-Carboxy- Δ^9 Tetrahydrocannabinol is 5ng/ml in blood.
