

Background

 Taught ISSE began in 2013 National Strategy for Higher Education to 2030 (Dept of Education and Skills, 2011)

 Research Degree Programme student were not included because pre-testing highlighted that questions were only appropriate to students on taught programmes.






Rationale


Implementation of Pilot Survey


