2018	DN500-DN550	<p>Our Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences degree programmes (currently ranging from DN500 to DN550) will be structured differently from 2018 entry and be replaced by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Three Arts and Humanities degree programmes (<i>DN520, DN530 and DN541</i>)- Four Social Sciences degree programmes (<i>DN700, DN710 , DN720 and DN750</i>) <p>See Page 3 and 4 for more details.</p>
2018	DN514 Planning, Geography and Environment	<p>Subject to University Programme Board approval in March 2017, the BA in Planning Geography and Environment will no longer be offered. However, it is proposed that a new three-year BSc in City Planning and Environmental Policy will be available for 2018 entry. Any updates will be added to our Alert List in April and uploaded to the CAO website.</p>
2017	DN670 Quantitative Business	<p>The degree option in 'Business Analytics' has been withdrawn for 2017 entry. 'Economics and Finance' will remain as the only degree pathway for those applying to DN670.</p>
2017	DN615 BCL Maîtrise	<p>The BCL Maîtrise will no longer exist as a separate entry pathway. Students who enter Law with French Law (DN600) can apply for a place in this degree option following first year.</p>
2017	DN140 Structural Engineering with Architecture	<p>Structural Engineering with Architecture will no longer be a separate entry pathway but will be a degree option in DN150 Engineering.</p>
2017	DN512 English with Drama	<p>English with Drama will no longer exist as a separate entry pathway. English and Drama Studies will be offered via DN500 BA Programme.</p>
2017	DN501 BA Part-time	<p>The BA Part-time programme is no longer a separate entry route. However, students who enter DN500 may opt to study part-time at registration.</p>
