Entry Procedure:

Candidates are short-listed on the basis of the written application.

Occasionally an interview may be deemed necessary to facilitate a decision in relation to an application.

Short-listed candidates will be expected to bring a portfolio with samples of creative work to their interview.

Applicants must ensure that they tick the Mature Special Category on the CAO application form and complete sections 1-11 of the Mature Application section. Initial selection is based on the information provided on the CAO application form.

Academic Ability

Detail any academic experience which may be relevant: your level of achievement may be displayed by final school leaving examinations and/or other assessed programmes or examinations.

Please enclose copies of results, transcripts and certificates where appropriate.

Work Experience

Record a brief history of all your work experience and give additional detail about any experience (work or life related) which may have particular relevance in applying for Landscape Architecture.

Specific Subject Requirements

Landscape Architecture requires you to have a demonstrable interest in design issue and the external environment, so you should elaborate on anything relevant to this in your application.

Motivation and Interest

A separate Personal Statement should be included explaining:

- your reasons for wishing to undertake a Landscape Architecture degree;
- your motivation/interest in the programme
