Entry Procedure:

Candidates are assessed on the basis of the written application and short-listed applicants may be required to attend for interview.

Selection is based on:

Academic Ability

Evidence of academic ability as displayed by final school leaving examinations and/or other assessed courses or examinations you have undertaken. Applicants must normally meet the minimum matriculation requirements (see main prospectus for details) for entry to the course.

Please enclose copies of results, transcripts and certificates, where appropriate.

Science Subject Requirement

A minimum grade 6 in Leaving Certificate Ordinary level (or equivalent) is required.

Work Experience

Please provide a CV outlining any relevant work experience (max. 2 x A4 pages).

Professional Development

Evidence of continuing professional development and/or relevant courses you have undertaken.

Motivation and Interest

A Personal Statement of commitment should be included explaining:

- your reasons/motivation for wishing to undertake a Physiotherapy degree;
- the degree's potential contribution to your plans for the future;
- your ability to work independently and to display initiative;
- your interpersonal abilities and communication skills;
- your knowledge of healthcare issues;
- your educational development and achievements;
- your involvement in social, medical or voluntary activities;
- other information which is relevant to your application.
