Applicants are asked to select two languages to study equally for the first semester of their Bachelor of Commerce (International) programme.

Following semester 1, students will decide which language to continue to degree level (Minor) and which language to drop.

Entry Procedure:

Candidates are short-listed on the basis of the written application. Short-listed candidates are then called for interview.

Academic Ability

Evidence of academic ability as displayed by final school leaving examinations and/or other assessed courses or examinations you have undertaken.

Please enclose copies of results, transcripts and certificates.

Mathematics Requirement

A minimum grade 6 in Leaving Certificate Higher Level or a minimum grade 3 in Leaving Certificate Ordinary Level (or equivalent) is required.
