### **Mathematics Requirement**

A minimum grade 4 in Leaving Certificate Higher Level (or equivalent) is required.

### **Relevant Occupational / Work Experience**

Detail any other experience (e.g. occupational/work experience) which is relevant to your application to do a Quantitative Business degree.

The School of Business particularly welcomes applicants with demonstrable ability and decision-making experience. Evidence of maturity, commitment and potential is sought.

### **Motivation and Interest**

A separate Personal Statement should be included explaining:

- your reasons for wishing to undertake a Quantitative Business degree;
- the degree's potential contribution to your plans for the future;
