In 2017, both standard and mature applicants will use the same course codes, listed above, when applying for Nursing and Midwifery degree programmes.

Each degree code can only be listed once on the CAO application form.

Mature applicants will be considered on their written assessment (see below) and may also be considered on the basis of their school leaving or QQI FET/FETAC Level 5 qualifications.

Please ensure that you provide all relevant information and results with your application.

N.B. Applicants should note that non-EU applicants to nursing programmes will only be considered after all eligible EU applicants have been considered.

Entry Procedure:

Details of entry & assessment procedures are available from the Nursing Careers Centre (NCC).

Having applied through the CAO before 1 February 2017 at 5.15pm, Mature Applicants must also register and apply for the written assessment through the PAS website www.publicjobs.ie by 22 February. This is required as PAS undertakes the written assessment on behalf of the NCC.
