- 50 programme credits & 10 Elective credits
- 10 Elective Credits- Can select from the option modules if preferred
- 6 Core Modules- 6 in Stage 2 & 3 with some common modules across all pathways:
 - **Stage 2: Common Core Modules**
 - Sociological Theory Level 2
 - Quantitative Sociology
 - Investigating Social Services
 - **Stage 3: Common Core Modules**
 - Qualitative Research
 - Social Policy Capstone Essay
