Do you hold one of the following for 3 of the 5 years prior to starting a programme:

1. EU/EEA/Switzerland Citizenship or
2. Official Refugee Status or
3. Refugee Family Member with permission to stay in the EU/EEA/Swiss Confederation or
3. EU family member with a "4EUFam" stamp or
4. Permanent residence / indefinite leave to remain in the EU/EEA/Swiss Confederation (e.g. Stamp 1, 4 or 5 visa) or
5. Humanitarian leave to stay in the EU/EEA/Swiss Confederation
