

Arab Republic of Egypt – Scholarship offer to Irish Students.

The Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Dublin has informed me that the Ministry of Higher Education of Egypt has decided to grant five scholarships to Irish students who wish to pursue their education in the field of Arabic studies.

The following conditions apply for enrolment in the Arabic Language Departments of Egyptian Universities:-

- Hold a secondary school leaving certificate (Irish, British or American);
- Passing eight O level subjects, including English Language or Literature, German or French and 4 other subjects – Geography, Maths, Social Studies, Consumer Maths, History, Economics, Accounting, Statistics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Sociology, Philosophy or Psychology;
- Applications should be submitted via the website of the Cultural Affairs and Scholarships Division of the Egyptian Ministry of Higher Education, <http://www.mohe-casm.edu.eg> by the end of August 2010 at the latest;
- Knowledge of the Arabic language is required and proficiency in the language would be an advantage;
- The applicant should send a photocopy of their leaving certificate, their passport, together with the completed application form found on the website. The original certificate must be sent after being certified by the Egyptian Embassy in Dublin as well as an original or copy of the applicant's birth certificate.
