

Collections: print and digital

- There are about 1 million books
- Short Loan Collection is where a lot of taught student texts are placed, 30k copies roughly at this time
- Around 80,000+ journal titles, e-journals increasingly
- 650,000 e-books available (via web) through various packages and set to increase
- 200+ databases

Special Collections contains unique book, archival and manuscript collections. UCD students and staff, and external users, can consult the collections in the Special Collections reading room. Speial Collections is located on Level 1 of the James Joyce Library.



This collection contains unique and irreplaceable documents which tell the stories of our culture's past.



Printed Collections

This collection contains books, pamphlets and journals on a variety of subjects spanning the 16th to the 20th century.
