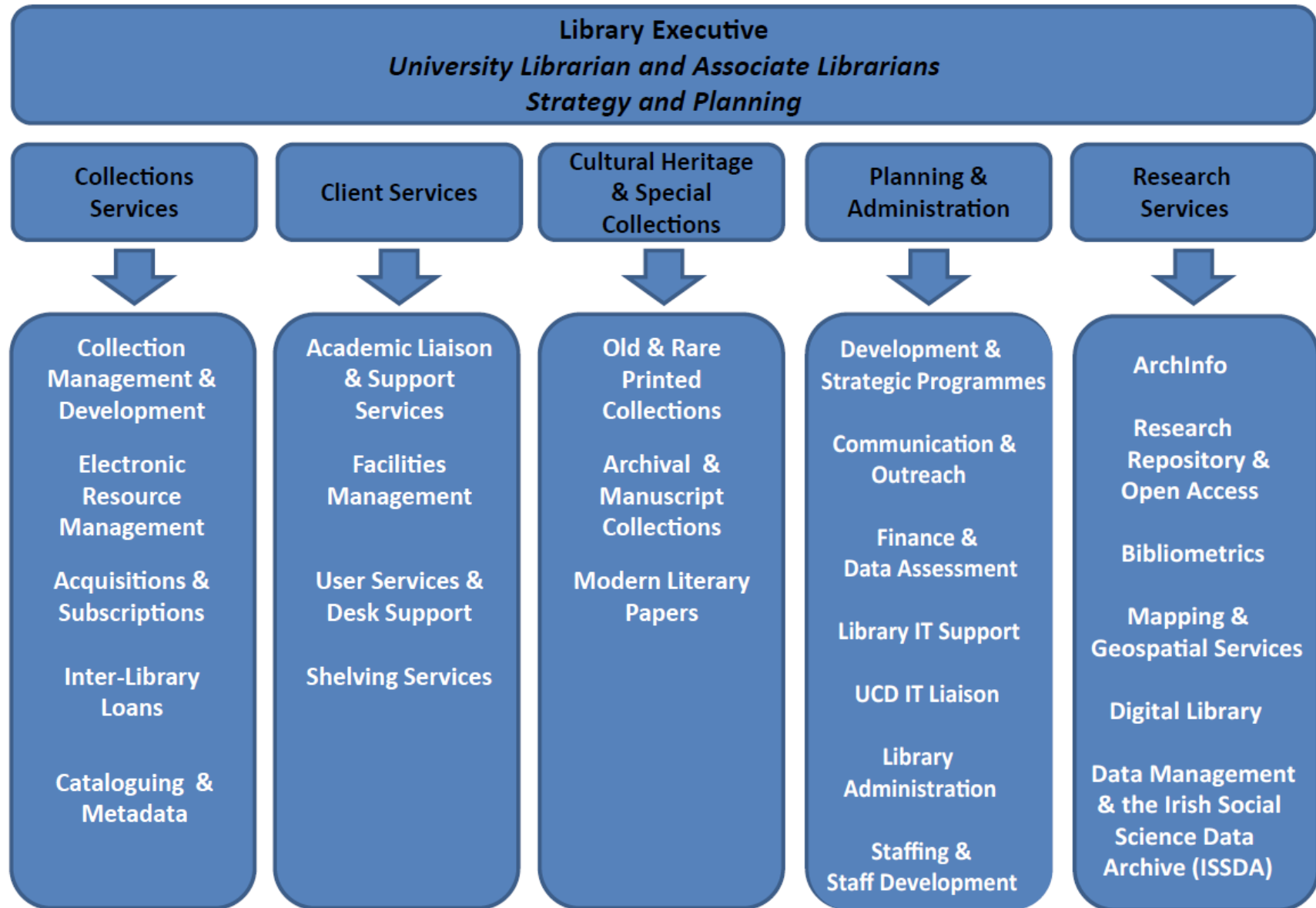

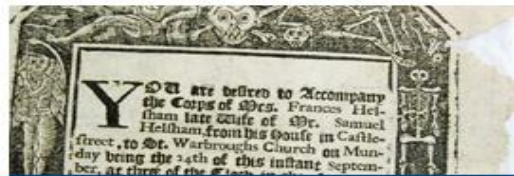
This collection contains unique and irreplaceable documents which tell the stories of our culture's past.
