Letters re imprisonment of Desmond FitzGerald 1916

Born in London of Irish parents. Desmond FitzGerald learnt irish at Caelic League classes where he met Mabei Washington McConnell, a Belfa Presbyterian and nationalist. The Urban Folklore Project of 1979-1980 has preserved a valuable audio record of Dublin's folklore and social history. The project was undertaken by the Department of Irish Folklore, University College Dublin, directed by Dr Séamas Û Catháin. It originated as a Government employment scheme to provide work for university graduates at a time of severe economic recession.
