Collections Services Unit is responsible for the management of all material published after 1930 held in UCD Library. This includes:



- Collection development, or the selection and acquisition of both print and online materials;
- Cataloguing of print and electronic resources to ensure ease of access;
- Decision making on the retention and disposal of materials in our collection.
- Managing and maximising the library's resources budget
- Participation in relevant national bodies and consortia, i.e. IReL (Irish Research Electronic Library)

Collections Services staff are responsible for selecting, ordering, and processing Library materials at every stage of their lifecycle. We will work with you to help you make the best use of the Library's existing resources and to select the most appropriate collections for your teaching, learning and research needs.

The Collections Services Unit is not responsible for UCD's special or archival collections. Any queries relating to **Special Collections**, the **National Folklore Archive**, or **UCD Archives** should be directed to the relevant department.

"History is made with documents. Documents are the imprints left of the thoughts and the deeds of the men of former times. For nothing can take the place of documents. No documents, no history."

Letters re imprisonment of Desmond Fitzgerald 1916

Born in London of Irish parents, Desmond Fitzgerald learnt Irish at Gaelic League classes where he met Mabel Washington McConnell, a Belfast Presbyterian and nationalist. They married in 1911 and lived in Brittany for two years in the company of writers and artists. While in London Fitzgerald had been a member of the Imagist group of poets which included Ezra Pound and T.S. Eliot. Mabel had acted for Bernard Shaw. 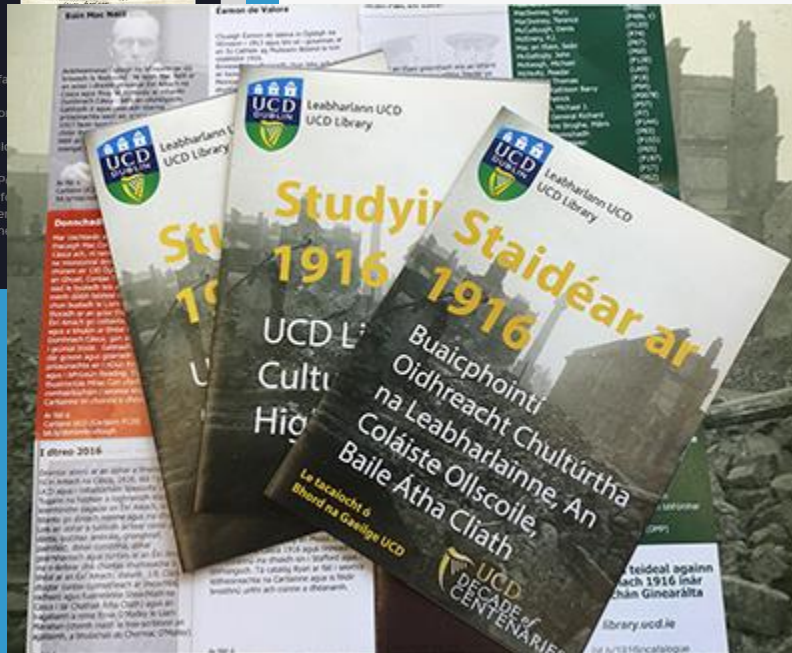
