We arrange and pay for transportation to University College Dublin from within a radius of 25 miles (if the distance exceeds 25 miles we have to ask the executor to pay the full cost of transportation). Unfortunately there are times when we are unable to accept a bequest. This might occur after we have discussed the deceased medical history with their doctor and occasionally we are unable to accept a bequest because of a shortage of appropriate facilities. While it is uncommon that we refuse to accept a donor's body at the time of death, it is important that the donor be aware of this possibility and make alternative plans if it should occur. We cannot accept a body that has had a post mortem performed. Therefore, we advise you to have an alternative plan, in the event that your body is unsuitable for donation.

We hold regular Multi-faith Services of Thanksgiving and Remembrance to acknowledge the very high-minded and charitable bequests made to our medical school. The Multi-faith Service of Thanksgiving and Remembrance comprises of music and readings from many different traditions including Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism and Sikhism by Medical, Physiotherapy and Radiography students. Our most recent service was held on 04 November 2009 in the Church of Our Lady Seat of Wisdom here on the Belfield Campus. I am enclosing a souvenir copy of our order of service.
