BA International French (DN531) Progression from Stage 1 to Stage 2

Archaeology (ARCH)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	YES
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Archaeology in Stage 2 having passed any two Archaeology modules offered in Stage 1.

Art History (AH)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Art History in Stage 2 having passed AH 10040 <i>Tools of Art History</i> and one other Art History module offered in Stage 1.

Economics (ECON)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Economics in Stage 2 having passed ECON 10010 <i>Principles of Microeconomics</i> and ECON 10020 <i>Principles of Macroeconomics</i> . Please note: ECON 10030 <i>Introduction to Quantitative Economics</i> is a compulsory module and must be passed prior to degree completion. Students are strongly recommended to pass ECON 10030 during Stage 1.

English (ENG)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	In order to progress with English in Stage 2, students must have passed the two core English modules offered in Stage 1: students who wish to progress must have passed ENG 10050 <i>Literature in Context</i> and ENG 10060 <i>Literature in Context 2</i> .

French & Francophone Studies (FR)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with French in Stage 2 having passed two modules in French offered at Stage 1. Students wishing to progress must have passed FR10070 <i>French Grammar and Expression</i> plus one other French module offered in Stage 1.
Special Note	BA (International) French students may elect to graduate with a Major/Minor combination if (a) they have amassed sufficient credit in French and (b) this change is permitted in their particular subjects.

German (GER)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	<p>FOR BEGINNERS: Students wishing to progress with German in Stage 2 must have passed GER 10100 <i>German Beginners A</i> and GER 10110 <i>German Beginners B</i>.</p> <p>FOR NON-BEGINNERS: Students may progress with German in Stage 2 having passed GER 10020 <i>German Language Ib</i> plus one other German module offered in Stage 1.</p>

Greek Mode B (GRK)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress to Stage 2 having completed 10 credits in Greek Mode B offered in Stage 1. Students wishing to progress must have passed GRK 10110 <i>Ancient Greek Language for Beginners 1</i> and GRK 10120 <i>Ancient Greek Language for Beginners 2</i> .

Greek and Roman Civilisation (GRC)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Greek and Roman Civilisation in Stage 2 having passed any two Greek and Roman Civilisation modules offered in Stage 1.

History (HIS)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with History in Stage 2 having passed any two History modules offered in Stage 1.

Information and Social Computing (IS)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Information and Social Computing in Stage 2 having passed any two of the Information and Social Computing modules offered in Stage 1.

Irish Folklore (IRFL)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Irish Folklore in Stage 2 having passed both core Irish Folklore modules offered in Stage 1.

Irish Studies (IRST)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Irish Studies in Stage 2 having passed both core Irish Studies modules offered in Stage 1.

Italian Studies (ITAL)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Italian in Stage 2 having passed two modules in Italian offered in Stage 1. Students wishing to progress must have passed ITAL 10030 <i>Italian Language 1b</i> plus one other Italian module offered in Stage 1.

Latin Mode A (LAT)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	In order to progress to Stage 2, students must have passed the ten-credit core module LAT20140 <i>Intermediate Latin</i> offered in Stage 1.

Latin Mode B (LAT)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress to Stage 2 having completed 10 credits in Latin Mode B in Stage 1. Students wishing to progress must have passed LAT 10110 <i>Beginners' Latin 1</i> and LAT 10120 <i>Beginners' Latin 2</i> .

Linguistics (LING)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Linguistics in Stage 2 having passed any two modules offered in Linguistics in Stage 1 Please note: students are advised to take LING 10040 <i>Words and Sentences</i> to avail of all possible options in Stage 2. Please contact the School of Irish, Celtic Studies, Irish Folklore and Linguistics for further information.

Mathematical Studies (MST)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Mathematical Studies in Stage 2 having passed MST 10010 <i>Calculus I</i> and MST 10030 <i>Linear Algebra I</i> offered in Stage 1. It is strongly recommended that students take all four Level 1 modules offered in Stage 1.

Modern Irish (IR)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Modern Irish in Stage 2 having passed IR 10040 <i>Tenga Na Gaeilge</i> plus one other Level 1 Modern Irish module offered in Stage 1.

Music (MUS)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Music in Stage 2 having passed the 10-credit core module MUS 10140 <i>Theory & Analysis of Tonality I</i> offered in Stage 1. Please note: students will be required to pass all three Level 1 Music modules offered in Stage 1 prior to degree completion.
Special Note	Music CANNOT be taken as a Minor. Therefore you cannot graduate with a Major/Minor classification where Music is the Minor component.

Philosophy (PHIL)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Philosophy in Stage 2 having passed any two Philosophy modules offered in Stage 1.

Politics (POL)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Politics in Stage 2 having passed any two modules from the Politics structures offered in Stage 1.

Sociology (SOC)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students may progress with Sociology in Stage 2 having passed any two of the Sociology modules offered in Stage 1. Please note: SOC 10010 <i>Foundations of Sociological Thought</i> is a compulsory module and must be passed prior to degree completion.

Spanish (SPAN)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	FOR BEGINNERS: Students who wish to progress with Spanish in Stage 2 must have passed SPAN10140 <i>Intensive ab initio Spanish 1a</i> and SPAN10150 <i>Intensive ab initio Spanish 1 b</i> . FOR NON-BEGINNERS: Students may progress with Spanish in Stage 2 having passed two modules in Spanish offered in Stage 1. Students who wish to progress must have passed SPAN10050 <i>Spanish Language 1b</i> and one other Spanish module offered in Stage 1.

Statistics (STAT)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Students who wish to progress with Statistics in Stage 2 must have passed STAT 10050 <i>Intro to Statistical Modelling</i> and STAT 10060 <i>Statistical Modelling in Stage 1</i> .

Welsh (WEL)

DN531	Joint Major (50 credits)
Availability	Yes
Progression	Straightforward progression – students may progress with Welsh in Stage 2 having passed both Welsh modules offered in Stage 1.
