

M.Sc. HUMANITARIAN ACTION- COURSE FEE EXPLAINED

Under this programme, students can choose their course track depending on their preference. They can participate in [NOHA Mundus \(i.e. Masters with mobility\)](#) or complete the entire [programme at UCD](#). The course fee is determined on the basis of (a) nationality of the student (EU/Non-EU)¹ and (b) the mobility path offered. The following table outlines the fee structure for different students depending on their nationality and mobility path:
