THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Course Title: Master of Education

Course Code: MTHSC004

Who is eligible to apply?

Candidates who hold an honours level primary degree or an honours post graduate certificate or diploma

Online application/ Interview

Prospective students should apply on line for the masters program. Students will be required to attend for a short interview prior to the offer of a place.

KEY DATES

May: Closing date for applications for is early May

Interview

Interviews will be conducted in the School of Education, Roebuck Castle during May and perspective students will receive a letter inviting them to attend for interview following the closing date for applications.

Notification of offer of a place

Provisional offers will be sent to successful candidates by the end of May. This offer is conditional on the student meeting the academic requirements which are checked prior to the student being passed by the Graduate Studies Board in UCD.

Further Communication:

Students will receive details from the registry and fees section of the University during August.

Students will receive a provisional timetable from the School of Education for all modules for the academic year during the last week of August. At this time they will be invited to attend an induction evening during the first week of September.

The academic year 2009/2010 begins on the second week in September. Students are typically required to attend two evenings per week from 5pm to 7pm.
