CHAPTER 1

AMENDMENT OF STATUTE 6, CHAPTER 8

Chapter 8 of Statute 6 is hereby replaced by the following amended text.

Chapter 8 Appeals in Relation to the Results of Examinations

- 1. The Academic Council shall establish a committee to consider appeals in relation to the results of examinations.
- 2. The Academic Council shall determine the procedures to be followed by the committee when considering appeals by students relating to examination results.

CHAPTER 2

DATE OF COMMENCEMENT

This statute shall come into operation on 17 May 2016. It may be cited as Statute 21 of University College Dublin, National University of Ireland, Dublin.
