

UCD Global Graduate Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

- 1) Applicants should be Indian citizens and currently resident in India;
- 2) Applicants must be self-funding and classified as non-EU for tuition fee purposes;
- 3) At the deadline applicants must hold an firm offer or acceptance to an eligible full time UCD Taught Masters;
- 4) The Scholarships are available for most Graduate Taught Masters offered by UCD with exception of Graduate Taught Masters in the areas of Medicine and Medical Science, Veterinary Medicine, or in the Smurfit School of Business, or for Joint Masters. Please contact kate.ohanlon@ucd.ie for advice of whether your programme of study is eligible.
- 5) Successful candidates will be selected on merit;
- 6) This scholarship is not eligible to be combined with any other tuition scholarship;

Award

- 7) The Scholarship Programme aims to attract excellent candidates and encourages early application;
- 8) Scholarship awards cover €2,000 to 50% of tuition fees per candidate;
- 9) Scholarship awards are applicable to tuition fees only;
- 10) Successful candidates will be selected on merit;
- 11) Decisions will be made by the Scholarship Committee on or before the 1st June 2013. All decisions are final.

- 12) Students should also apply to their chosen course as normal at www.ucd.ie/apply;
- 13) All eligible applications received by 30th April 2013 will be considered.
- 14) No seperate application form is required
