How to Get to UCD from the Airport

At the airport you have get to the "Aircoach" bus service and take the line that goes to Leopardstown. This line has a stop at UCD. Depending on time of day and traffic it can take you anything between 45 and 90 minutes to get there (the airport is in the far North of Dublin, our campus South of the city centre). If your hotel is in the City Centre you can alternatively also use the Aircoach line heading for Ballsbridge.

Below you can find a link to a map of our campus. Coming from the direction of Donnybrook you will arrive at a bus stop on campus (C10, near building no. 69). Your room will be in the Roebuck Hall residences (F11, building no. 61 on the map), but first you have to make your way to the Merville Residences (D11, no. 37) where you have to register and get our key in the central accommodation office. This office is next to a supermarket.

The conference will take place in the Newman Building (D8, no. 41); the restaurant is right next to it (D9, no. 51).
