

Trans-vaginal scanning brings together clinical dexterity, interpretation and reporting skills unique to this modality. The morning lecture based session is designed to give operators an opportunity to gain valuable theoretical knowledge, often obtained in an ad hoc way in the clinical setting.

This theoretical morning session will be complimented by an optional small group workshop in the afternoon which will allow a small number of candidates to put theory into practice.

This study day, hosted by UCD School of Medicine and Medical Science is targeted towards Sonographers, Midwives, Radiologists and Medical Doctors who perform gynaecological scanning as part of their routine workload.
