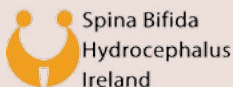

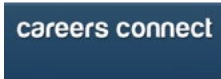
CAREERS FAIRS & EMPLOYER PRESENTATIONS

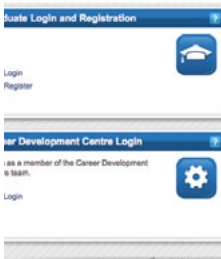
