# Check your Route to Campus using Public Transport

## Transport for Ireland

Transport for Ireland ([www.transportforireland.ie](http://www.transportforireland.ie)) helps you plan journeys, door-to-door, anywhere in Ireland, using public transport and/or walking.

## Hit the Road

Hit the Road ([www.hittheroad.ie](http://www.hittheroad.ie)) shows you how to get between any two points in Dublin City, using a smart combination of Dublin Bus, LUAS and DART routes.

- UCD-LUAS shuttle bus to Windy Arbour on the LUAS Green Line during term time

- Greater bike security through extended CCTV coverage
- Additional showering and changing facilities (UCD Sports Centre & UCD O'Brien Centre for Science)
- Secure bike lockers

# Commuting by Car



Parking is limited on campus and available on a first come first served basis exclusively for persons with business in UCD.

All car parks are designated either permit parking or hourly paid. Eligible UCD Community members may apply for a parking permit. For full details and to apply see [www.ucd.ie/commuting](http://www.ucd.ie/commuting).

Some areas on campus are reserved for specified users and are signposted. Please park in accordance with the UCD parking regulations and note that parking enforcement measures include fines, clamping and towing. See [www.ucd.ie/commuting](http://www.ucd.ie/commuting) for regulations.

**Premium Spaces** are premium rate **hourly paid** spaces that are designed to ensure that short-term parking is always available on the Belfield campus. They are marked as yellow spaces and are located:

- **Beside the AIB Bank, in the Tierney car park**
- **Richview car park**
- **NovaUCD car park**
- **Opposite Health Sciences alongside Student Centre car park**

**Traffic calming barriers** are in place to prevent through traffic and make the campus safer for pedestrians and cyclists. They operate 07.00hrs to 10.30hrs and from 16.00hrs to 19.30hrs Monday to Friday all year round.

**GoCar** - UCD provides a GoBase for GoCars and free parking for GoCars

**Carsharing** - Join UCD's free carsharing group and save money by sharing journeys - see [www.carsharing.ie/ucd](http://www.carsharing.ie/ucd)

**E-car** - Electric car charging points are available on campus




## GET YOUR STUDENT LEAP CARD

## Bus



### DUBLIN BUS SERVICES

There are currently 16 routes served by Dublin Bus to and from the campus, including a number of express services.

Several of these services stop at Connolly Station and Heuston Station:

**Connolly:** 27x, 32x

**Heuston:** 145, 67x, 66x, 51x, 25x

### BUS ÉIREANN SERVICES

Bus Éireann provides a nationwide bus service, with most major areas having a regular link to Dublin. The majority of services terminate in Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin) from where it is a short walk to O'Connell Street for connecting buses to UCD. Several Bus Éireann services from the Greater Dublin area directly serve UCD, Belfield Campus during morning peak hours.

### PRIVATE BUS SERVICES

Aircoach operates a service from Dublin Airport to Leopardstown / Sandyford / Stillorgan which passes UCD.

Wexford Bus also operates a service from Dublin Airport which goes via UCD to Wexford town.

### WHERE IS THE BUS STOP?

There are two main bus stopping areas on the UCD campus.

1. The main terminus is beside the Glenomena Residences
2. There's another beside the UCD Sports Centre.

There are several other stops on the Stillorgan Road (N11) and on the Clonskeagh Road. See map overleaf or use a Transport for Ireland App.

## Tram



### LUAS SERVICES

Windy Arbour is the nearest LUAS stop to the UCD campus. It's on the Green Line, which serves from Stephen's Green to Sandyford or Bride's Glen, and vice versa.

UCD is planning to introduce a subsidised UCD-LUAS shuttle bus to Windy Arbour on the LUAS Green Line during term time.

## Train



### DART SERVICES

The closest DART stations to UCD are the Sydney Parade and Booterstown stations. The DART runs from Bray in the South, to Malahide and Howth in the North.

A subsidised UCD shuttle bus departs to and from O'Reilly Hall car park for Sydney Parade from 8am to 10am & from 4pm to 6pm during term time.

### COMMUTER SERVICES

Commuter Services run from stations nationwide to Heuston and Connolly stations. The 145 Bus brings you to and from Heuston station. Certain commuter services going through Connolly, continue to Sydney Parade. Alternatively, transferring to the DART at Connolly Station will bring you to Sydney Parade.
