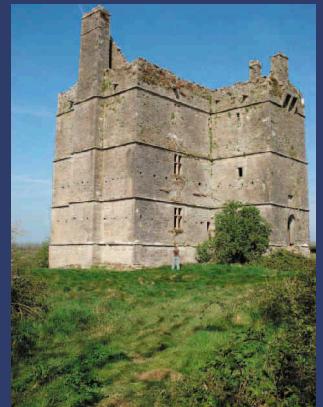




Graduate opportunities

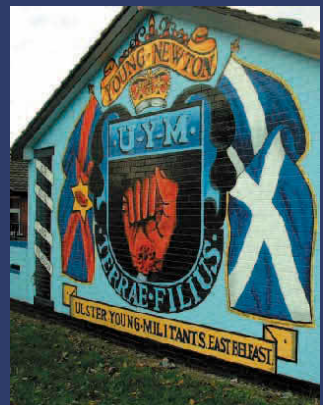
Higher Diploma in Archaeological Studies

The HDip is designed for students whose primary degree is not in archaeology or a cognate discipline. It introduces these students to core skills, themes and debates in archaeology. The HDip can also be taken in a three year structure.



MA in Archaeology/ GradDip in Archaeological Studies

The Masters and Graduate Diplomas are for students with a primary degree in archaeology or a cognate discipline. They develop student's existing skill sets with an emphasis on practical and interpretative skills. Designed with a core and option structure, the programmes allow students considerable flexibility in determining their pathways.



MA in Archaeological Practice

This programme offers a specialisation in applied archaeological skills (management, project coordination etc.) and is especially useful for those working within the archaeological profession.

MLitt/PhD in Archaeology

The School of Archaeology offers supervision for MLitt through to PhD level in accordance with UCD's new structured doctoral programme on full-time and part-time basis.
