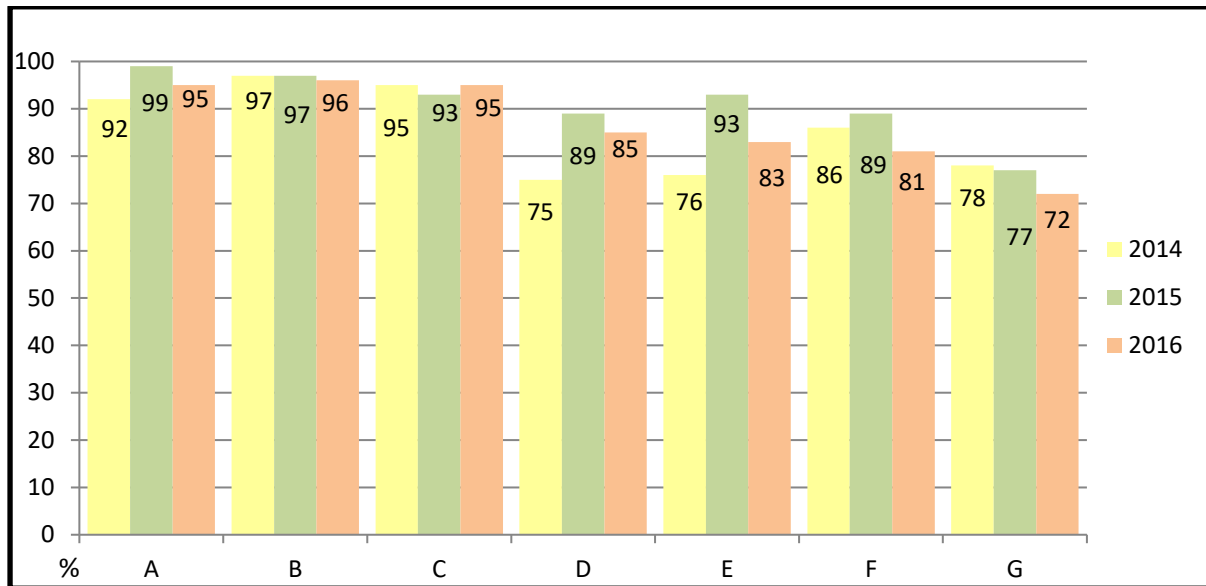

Helpfulness to learning of programme components

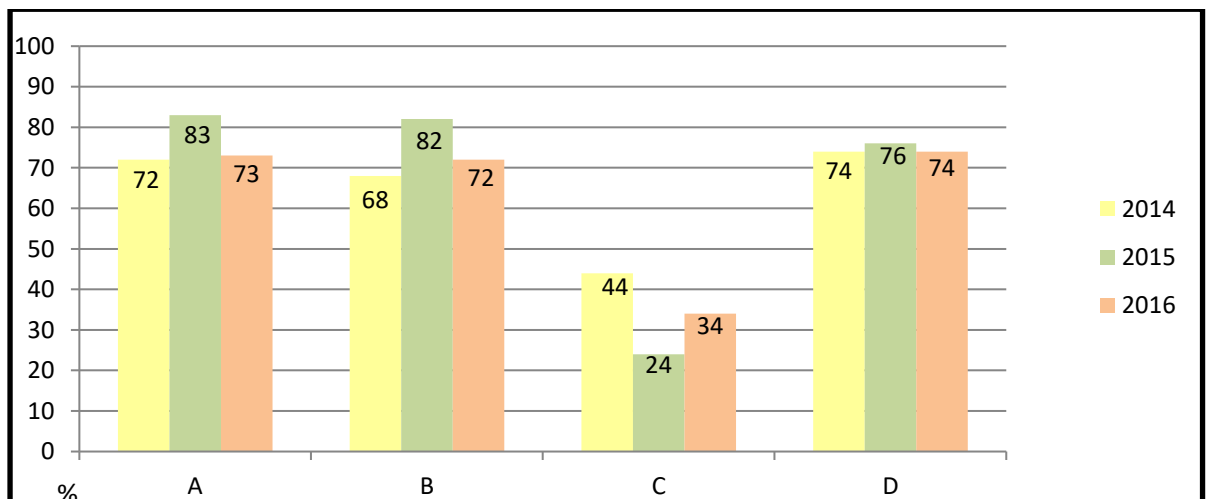


A = Online Lectures

Mid-programme evaluation: responses to question on the extent to which students agreed or disagreed with the statements above regarding different programme components. Combined proportion of those who responded 'agree' or 'strongly agree' are shown (other response options were 'neither agree nor disagree OR 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree'). The average response rate is 90%. Percentages shown above are the valid % for each question.
