Spotlight on Social Work

There are two postgraduate routes to gaining a professional qualification in Social Work in Ireland. Holders of a Bachelor of Social Science degree may apply for a place on the Masters programmes offered by the following universities:

- University College Cork: Master of Social Work/Higher Diploma in Social Work Studies
- University College Dublin: Masters of Social Science (Social Work)
- Trinity College Dublin: Masters in Social Work
- University College Galway: Master in Social Work

In addition to meeting the academic criteria for these programmes relevant experience is essential. Holders of a degree in a subject other than Social Science can do a diploma in social policy or in some cases, a compensatory learning package/ assignment may be offered in order to be eligible for a postgraduate course.
