

Continuation and Readmission Process Map Part 2: Re-admission

In general, UCD Admissions will advise relevant Governing Boards of:

- a) Undergraduate EU CAO applicants who were previously discontinued from a UCD programme, and
- b) previously discontinued students who apply for readmission to the same programme.

- Admission Tutors (or those with delegated authority, including the International Office) will advise relevant Governing Boards of discontinued students who apply for a graduate programme in UCD.
- A request has been made (Nov 2017) to MSU to create a flag so that Admissions can view discontinued status for graduate applicants; in the meantime Admission Tutors have visibility of an applicant's status, including discontinued status.
- University Secretariat, immediately following a discontinuation, will place a HOLD on the record of discontinued students, so that, if a 'discontinued' student applies for re-admission to the same UCD programme or to a different UCD programme, the relevant Governing Board can be advised of that applicant's 'discontinued' status.
