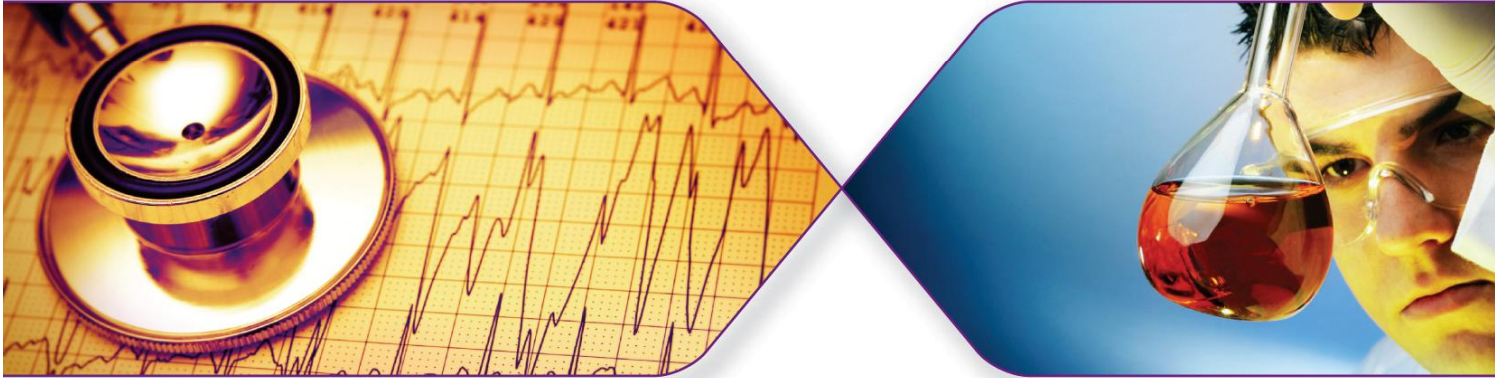

Graduate Diploma and MSc in Medicine Healthcare Informatics

Programme Title: Graduate Diploma and MSc in Medicine(Healthcare Informatics)

Duration: One Year for each course

Fee: Currently NDP funded for qualifying EU nationals - 2009-2010 – 2,000 euros for each course

Course Description:

Graduate Diploma in Medicine (Healthcare Informatics)

Students who pass the Graduate Diploma can opt to be conferred with the Graduate Diploma or to register for the MSc (Healthcare Informatics).

MSc (Healthcare Informatics)

Students can take the MSc (Taught) either full-time over three months following the Grad Dip course, or part-time over a year. The courses are a blended learning experience, combining face-to-face and online learning. Examination will be by project work, end of module MCQ and essays. The MSc will be examined solely by dissertation. The courses will be delivered by staff of the School of Medicine and Medical Science and by invited experts mostly from the UCD teaching Hospitals.

Admission Requirements: Students are either graduates in medicine and allied professions or from an ICT background and working in the health industry.

Career Opportunities:

The health IT sector is fast expanding and there will be increasing employment opportunities in this area for medical and allied graduates with informatics skills and for informaticians generally who train in health IT.

What have past graduates done:

Graduates are working in many areas of clinical medicine, in allied health professions and in medical ICT.

Why should you do this programme:

Information management and the utilisation of associated technology is becoming a major activity of the healthcare professional. These courses are designed to train graduates in medical and allied professions in Healthcare Informatics and to train those from an ICT background in Health Informatics.
