Any one of the following qualifications is acceptable as the minimum English language requirement for entry to University College Dublin.

- A minimum score of 550 in the TOEFL test (220 on computer-based testing).
- A minimum average score of 6.2 in the IELTS test (Academic), with not less than 6 in any individual component.
- Irish Leaving Certificate English at Grade D3 Ordinary Level or above.
- GCE 'O' Level English Language at Grade C or above.
- GCSE English Language at Grade C or above.
- CSE Grade 1 Pass in English.
- Hong Kong Certificate in Education: English Language Syllabus B, Grade C or above.
- Hong Examination Authority: Advanced Level Use of English at Grade C or above.
- Joint Matriculation Board (JMB): Test in English (Overseas) examination – Pass.
- Oxford Examining Body: English as a Foreign Language – Pass.
- Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate: School Certificate Pass (in the range 1-6).
- University of London Entrance and School Examinations Council: School Certificate Pass (in the range of 1-6).
- Matriculation examinations from European countries where English is presented as a subject and an acceptable level is achieved.

Other evidence of proficiency in English may be accepted. Advice may be obtained from the International Office, Michael Tierney Building, University College Dublin, Belfield.
