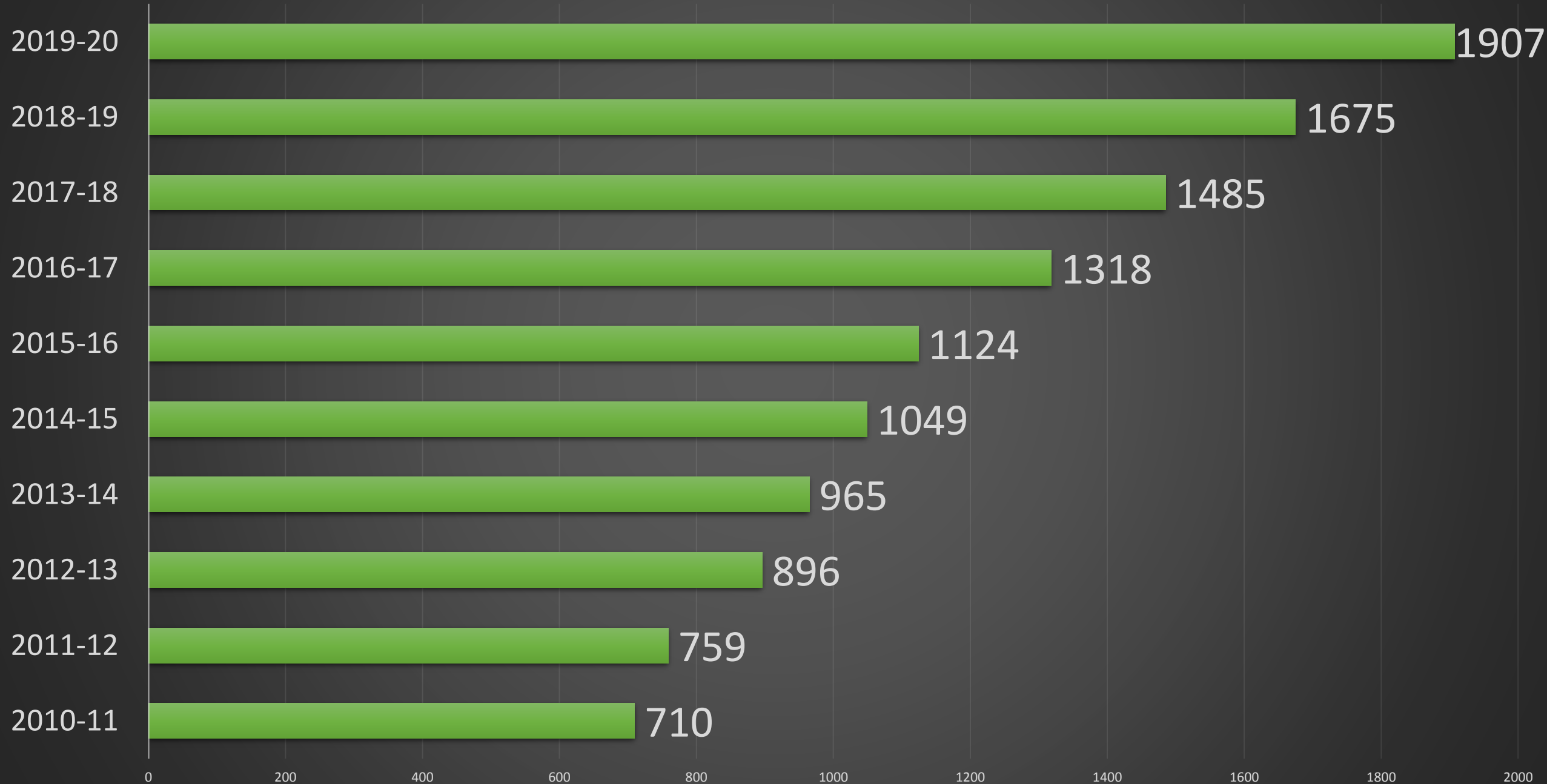


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Students with Disability Supports in UCD

Strategy & Approach

Supporting transition to third level.

Independent learning skills.

Encouraging use of mainstream UCD supports.

Supporting self-advocacy.

Communication and disclosure to staff.

Preparation for the workplace.



Individual Student Needs

- Students are invited to needs assessment where their individual needs and preferences are discussed.
- Supports are regularly reviewed and updated and can include:
 - Additional time in exams.
 - Smaller exam venue.
 - Assistive Technology.
 - Lecturer awareness.
 - Provision of lecture slides.



Supports for Students

In addition to Reasonable Accommodations students are offered a suite of pre- and post-entry supports which may include:

- Tailored Welcome Programme.
- Academic Skills workshops and access to online materials.
- Access to a dedicated Disability Adviser.
- Digital Ambassadors
- One-to-one learning support.
- One-to-one Occupational Therapy support.

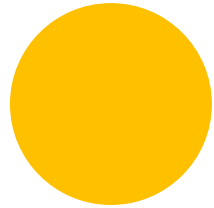
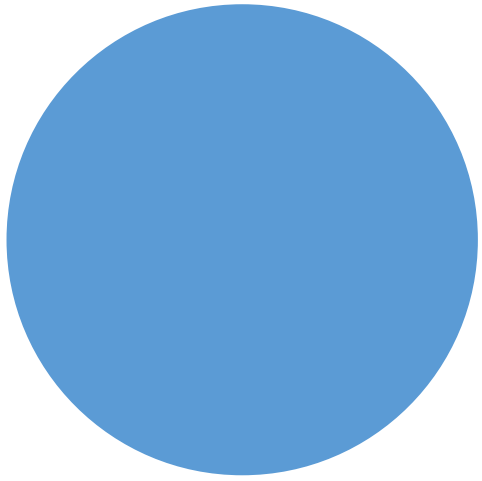

Positive Things That You Can Do to Support Students with Disabilities

- Let students know that you know about them and offer support – the vast majority have hidden disabilities.
- Proactively put supports in place for online exams and class tests.
- Provide students with the lecture slides and encourage the use of technology in your classroom. If you are lecturing online, then record the lecture and make it available.
- Flexibility within modules.
