1916 Bursary Scholarship - Supporting Documents

If you are

- Socioeconomically disadvantaged and eligible to apply for the SUSI SPECIAL Rate Grant AND/OR
- A member of the Traveller or Roma Community AND /OR
- Have a physical and/or intellectual disability.

Depending on which category you fall into you may need the following 2022 Financial Year documents. It is essential that you check the 1916 Bursary website

Statement of payments from Social Protection

Chapter 4 Notice of Assessment

- The **Statement of Liability for 2022 financial year** can be obtained from Revenue or through your **mygovid** account. If you do not have an account, it is easy to set one up at www.mygovid.ie
 - The **Statement of Social Protection payment for 2022** can be obtained from the Department of Social Protection or through your mygovid.ie account.
 - All documents should be in **JPEG, PDF, DOC or DOCX** format.
 - The **Cothrom na Féinne** scholarship is not counted as reckonable income by SUSI.
