

Tips for using SensusAccess

CUSTOMISE YOUR NOTES

Do you find PDF files hard to work with? Do you like to highlight important information as you read? Or maybe you find certain fonts easier to follow?

Try: converting a PDF into a Word Document for easy editing.



GET AWAY FROM YOUR DESK

Are you fed up of sitting at your laptop? Have you had too much screen time? Do you find it easier to retain information aurally?

Try: converting a journal article to mp3 and listening to it on your phone.



MIX UP YOUR LEARNING

Trying to learn a language and want to practice your pronunciation? Struggling to memorise a presentation?

Try: listening along to your reading by converting to an mp3 audio file.



MAKE INFORMATION CLEARER

Have you been sent a scan of a texbook? Do you use read-aloud software and it won't work? Is it awkward to zoom in on the words and to adjust the text?

Try: converting to an OCR PDF - 'PDF (text over image)'



SHARE INFORMATION EASILY

Want to access a PowerPoint on your phone but don't have the app? Working on a project with people who use different software to yourself? Trying to save space on your laptop?

Try the accessibility conversion options for compatible file types eg. RTF and plain text.



PROMOTE ACCESSIBILITY

We all study in different ways using different tools. SensusAccess can produce files in all sorts of forms including braille, DAISY audiobook, tagged pdf (useful for read aloud software, and screenreaders). Why not tell your classmates about this tool?
