Context

Biographical history

Seosamh Ó Duibhginn was born in Co Armagh in 1914. He became involved in republican activity from an early age; was imprisoned in Crumlin Road Gaol in Belfast for membership of the IRA when he was nineteen; and was interned in the Curragh Camp during World War II. He was also a member of the radical Irish language political movement, Ailtirí na hAiséirighe. A writer by inclination, it took some time for his career to flourish. He worked as a labourer in Liverpool in the late 1930s and on his return to Ireland, as a handyman.

During his internment in the Curragh he learnt Irish from renowned author Máirtín Ó Cadhain; and later undertook a certificate in Irish language and literature in Trinity College Dublin where Ó Cadhain was one of his lecturers.

In 1954, he was instrumental in the foundation of An Clóchomhar Tta, an Irish language publishing house and as chairperson of Coiste na Leabhar (The Books' Committee), he oversaw publications of works from authors such as Máirtín Ó Díreáin, Seán Ó Tuama and Dónall MacAmhlaigh. His own publishing career began properly in 1960 when he edited the Irish ballad 'Dónall Óg'. This was followed by two other scholarly works (*An Muircheartaigh*, 1970 and *Séamus MacGiollaChoille*, 1972) and two autobiographies (*Ag Scaoileadh Sceoil*, 1962 and *Tuairisc*, 1982).

Ó Duibhginn was an Irish language advocate and a member of Conradh na Gaeilge, Comhdháil Náisiúnta na Gaeilge, and Bórd na Leabhar Gaeilge. He was employed as part-time editor of <u>Feasta</u>, the official journal of Conradh na Gaeilge until 1963 when he took a full-time post as Irish language editor for the Irish Press group (*Scéala Éireann, Sunday Press*). His weekly columns were well regarded: 'An Mhuintir Seo Againne' and 'I Mo Thuairimse'. He retired from his post in 1979 and died in 1994.

Ephemera from Ó Duibghinn's time as a member of the above branch of Conradh na Gaeilge in Liverpool where he worked briefly. Includes a pamphlet containing a history of Conradh na Gaeilge in Liverpool, an annual report and an outline of the activities of the branch. Also includes a series of letters written by Eoin MacConmidhe, in Chicago, USA, who had been in England at the same time as Ó Duibhginn, in which they try to remember mutual friends and acquaintances.

- 1.Photocopy of the 'S Plan' (1938) containing a very detailed military plan of a guerrilla war to be carried out in England in the course of reuniting the twenty-six county Free State with the six occupied counties. States that an ultimatum would be issued to the British Prime Minister, the Prime Minister of Northern Ireland, the Prime Minister of Southern Ireland, the Vatican, the French and American presidents and to ambassadors of Germany and Italy. Outlines in diagrams the sequence of planned attacks aimed at creating chaos in Britain. (The last page of the plan is missing.)
- 2. Copy letter from Patrick Fleming, Secretary of the IRA, to the Home Secretary of the UK, issuing an ultimatum regarding the withdrawal of British troops from the six Northern counties. (12 January 1939)
- 3. Proclamation of 1939 signed on behalf of the Republican government and the Army Council of the IRA: Stephen Hayes (Chief of Staff), Patrick Fleming (Secretary), Peadar O'Flaherty, George Plunkett, Laurence Grogan and Seán Russell.
- 4. Original communiqué issued by the Army Council of the IRA containing the transcript of the confession of treachery

and court martial of Stephen Hayes, Chief of Staff. Contains details of the 'S Plan' or 'English Campaign' planned for Winter 1938, and how Hayes allegedly acted with Free State government to minimize and weaken the campaign by leaking operational information to Dr James Ryan T.D., Minister for Agriculture; Thomas Derrig T.D., Minister for Education, Senator Chris Byrne and Laurence de Lacy (1941).

Ailtirí na hAiséirighe/Architects of the Resurgence

see also p172/11 Letters, pamphlets, and cuttings concerning the radical nationalist organisation Ailtirí na hAiséirighe (known as 'Aiséirí'). Aiséirí was preceded by 'Craobh na hAiséirí' of Conradh na Gaeilge which was founded in 1940 and attracted the Irish language intelligentsia. In 1942, the branch split into two groups, the more radically minded Gearóid Ó Cuinneagáin forming Ailtirí na hAiséirghe and Proinsias Mac an Bheatha forming Glún na Buaidhe (Generation of Victory), a purely Irish language body. Aiséirí's aims were ambitious: 'a new order for a new Ireland' and 'a Christian alternative to the servile state'. Ultimately they failed to make any impact in the elections in 1943 and 1944.
