Weekly MDT in each discipline facilitating study awareness and accrual.

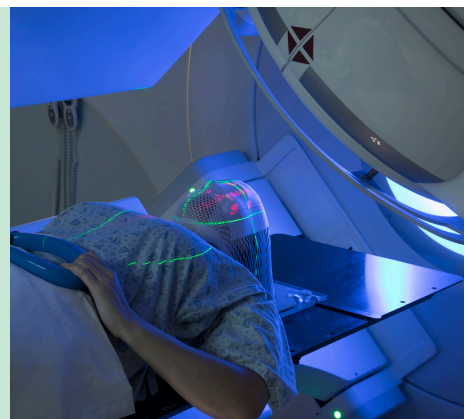


3,000+ New diagnoses each year

Approximately 10% of cancer patients are enrolled into interventional or translational research studies.

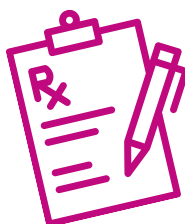

Trial Delivery Teams

01 Research Nurses

Expert Research Nurses take leadership in the day-to-day running of the clinical trials. Each trial is assigned to one of our nurses, ensuring it receives the attention it requires.

02 Clinical Trial Pharmacist

St Vincent's University Hospital employs a dedicated clinical trial pharmacist to ensure accurate drug management, protocol adherence, regulatory compliance, and patient safety.

03 Data managers

Experienced data managers ensure that the trial data are recorded and reported in an accurate and timely manner.

04 Study Startup Coordinator

Startup Coordinators support researchers and industry partners to get the trial approved, including the navigation of local standards, practices, and ethics.

05 Clinical Trial Programme Manager

A Programme Manager provides support to the unit as a whole to ensure integration amongst the teams and research groups.

06 Data & Safety Coordinator

A dedicated Data and Safety coordinator ensures that research data is handled with integrity and studies are conducted safely.

07 Translational Research Assistants

Direct research support is provided to translational research studies, including the processing of biological samples.

08 Operations Manager

An experienced Operations Manager provides unrivalled support with financial and contractual issues.

09 Quality & Training Coordinator

A Quality and Training Coordinator oversees trial quality to ensure protocol adherence and manages staff training to ensure the team is constantly upskilling.





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
