Expressions of Interest are now sought from across the College for the role of Vice Principal for Teaching and Learning.

The role of Vice Principal for Teaching and Learning is to support the College Principal and College Executive, by providing leadership and strategic advice on matters relating to teaching and learning, supporting and promoting the development of best practice in curriculum design, teaching, learning, education and assessment.

The VPTL will also represent the College at University level committees, and work with other VPTLs in the University to implement Teaching and Learning work programmes and represent UCD at teaching and learning fora.

This is a three-year role. Expressions of Interest are welcome from faculty across the College. It is a mandatory requirement of the appointee to hold or have held, at minimum, an Associate Dean position, or equivalent leadership position, at School, College or University level.

Expressions of Interest, including a CV and Cover Letter, should be sent to chasprincipal@ucd.ie by 2pm on Friday 25th June.

Responsibilities of the role include:

- Chair the College Education and Training Group and provide leadership for Teaching and Learning.
- Together with the relevant Associate Deans, support curricular and co-curricular projects to enable the embedding of best practice in taught programmes within the College
- Promote best practice and developments in curriculum design, teaching, learning and assessment strategies.
- Identify and showcase current CHAS strengths in Education and Training, as well as identify new areas for growth that can be developed through targeted support.
- Highlight and promote the College Objectives for Education and Training as outlined in the CHAS Mission, Vision and Strategic Objectives document.
- Through the College Education and Training Group, support and contribute to the development of multidisciplinary educational initiatives across the College.
- Work closely with the College Principal, Heads of School and other Vice-Principals in the College as a member of the College Executive.
- Where nominated by the College Principal, represent the College as required on relevant College and University structures.
- All other duties commensurate with this role.
