chemically contaminated red bags and waste alumina/silica

Alumina & Silica

No sharps or free liquids! Bags must not be torn.

biologically contaminated yellow bags

UN approved bags available from Stores

No sharps or free liquids! Bags must not be torn.

chemically contaminated glass and sharps

Containers must be sealed.

10L solvent and aqueous waste containers

Containers must be sealed. Line containers up as pictured.

biologically contaminated rigid tubs

Containers must be sealed.

Beside the shelves on the left.

All containers must be triple washed and labels removed!
