



Criteria Regarding Applications for Conway Fellowship – Fellow & Senior Fellows

Both Categories

Research should be relevant to at least one of the Institute thematic areas of research (*Personalised & Translational Medicine, One Health and Discovery Research*).

Fellow

- Investigators within first 3-5 years of academic appointment or personal fellowship
- Will have ordinarily completed 1 or 2 post-doctoral fellowships
- Already demonstrated potential in terms of publications and grant funding
- Likely, given appropriate research environment, to advance to Conway Senior Fellow over the next 5-10 years
- Confirmation of support from a Conway Senior Fellow as mentor
- Normal duration: 3 years (open to adjustment downwards, e.g. 1-2 years)

Senior Fellow

- Investigators with an established track record of high-quality scientific productivity, as judged by publications in international peer-reviewed journals and successful acquisition of substantive extramural funding
- Willing to provide a mentorship function to new Fellows
- Normal duration: 5 years

Process in Terms of First-Time Applications and Renewals

- Candidate is advised to submit application (or renewal) via online process, along with CV [renewal notifications sent 1-2 months before expiry of fellowship period]
- Additional details may be sought by the Director following initial inspection of application
- Finalised applications are first reviewed by Director for suitability – a recommendation to either award or not is given
- Applications then sent to Theme Champions of research area the candidate mostly identifies with
- Candidates must have positive report from at least 2 individuals from the Director / Theme Champions
- Feedback provided by Director (or delegate) to candidate
