## File storage and sharing in UCD

### UCD File Storage & Sharing Guide on the IT Services website

- Google Drive is secure and recommended for all types of information, including personal data and confidential university information
- Systems specifically designed for storing personal data as student, personnel and medical records e.g. Banner, InfoHub, PeopleXD
- Not recommended for storing university information:
   OneDrive, DropBox, personal devices or accounts, USB keys
- GDPR/data protection support and resources:
  - > UCD Legal UCD Data Protection Officer (DPO) www.ucd.ie/gdpr




## Features of Google Drive

- Security: part of UCD Google Workspace suite
- More visibility and control over access
- Less duplication: <u>send a link, not an attachment</u>
- One file, various types of access to it
- File access without folder access or Drive access



# Structure of Google Drive




Drive/Shared Drive

**Folders** 


**Files**

# New: Activity & Workspaces




#### **Activity**

 This page shows all pending access requests, recent comments, and approvals for files to help you quickly see recent activity and take action, all in one place.

### Workspaces

- You can create your own personalised Workspaces to collect any files you have access to, including content stored in your My Drive and various shared Drives.
- To add to a Workspace, right-click on any file and select Add to Workspace to group files as you work.
- Note: There is a 25 file limit for each Workspace you create.

# My Drive vs. Shared Drive



#### **My Drive**


- Your own personal drive space When you go, it goes files shared from it will be inaccessible

#### **Shared Drives**

- A place for a school/unit shared documents & team folders Files in it belong to the Shared Drive: no loss of files Manager rights can be shared and transferred No extra account or password required We recommend a **centralised Shared Drive structure** for your school or unit
- => Move, save and store your work in a Shared Drive folder!

## Shared with Me and Starred



#### Shared with me

- Somebody has shared a file with you, and when you share a file from your "My Drive", it goes into the "Shared with me" section for whoever you are sharing with.
- When the owner goes, it goes files shared from it will be inaccessible
- My Drive, Shared Drive, Shared with me

#### **Starred**

- Starring files and folders is a way for you to classify items
- How to star files or folders on Google Drive to make them easier to locate


## Sharing options: access types

- Manager: full admin & editor rights of the shared drive; manage folders, files, access and settings
- Content Manager: can add, edit, delete & give access to files; can't add, edit, delete or give access to folders
- **Contributor**: can add and edit files; can't delete files
- **Editor**: of a file; can give access to that file
- **Commenter**: can view and comment; can't give access
- Viewer: view only; can't give access. <u>Share a file as read-only</u>
- Sharing with visitors



Ensure that you are sharing only with the intended recipients and only for as long as is necessary. This is particularly important if you are sharing material outside of the organisation.

- Review suggested structure (sample only)
- Create a shared Drive and edit settings
- Check details and activity
- Share files
- Get a link to a folder/file
- Move files
- Create a shortcut



# Transferring file ownership

- If you're leaving UCD: <u>transfer ownership</u> of files saved in My Drive (or local machine). Shared Drive > files remain, no action needed to transfer ownership/
- Use advanced search to identify those files
  - You need to transfer ownership at the **file level** and not the folder level in Google Drive. Google folder ownership is not
    cascading, which means that changing the owner of a folder does not automatically change the ownership of each file and
    subfolder within that folder.
  - You can select multiple files by clicking and dragging your cursor over the relevant files from your search results.
  - If there are **Google Shortcuts** (i.e. links that reference another Drive file or folder) within your search results, you will need to <u>unselect those</u> before attempting to bulk share and transfer ownership of multiple files, or they will prevent you from bulk sharing/transferring. Unfortunately, there is no way to exclude Shortcuts from your search results at this time.
  - You can only transfer ownership of files to **other UCD accounts**. To transfer your personal data from your UCD Google
    Workspace account, use Google Takeout. You should note when transferring data out of the University account you must
    ensure that any confidential or restricted University data is NOT included.
  - To transfer ownership of a file to somebody else at UCD, it must **already be shared with them**. If the user you intend to transfer ownership to is not shared on the file(s), share the file with them first, before proceeding with the next steps.




Remember, UCD IT Services recommends that you save your work in a folder on your school or unit's **Shared Drive** in Google Drive: even if the person who created content saved in a Shared Drive leaves or has his or her account disabled, the content will remain accessible to everyone else in the Shared Drive.

# File storage & sharing best practices

- 1. Read the <u>UCD File Storage & Sharing Guide</u>
- 2. Consult the University's <u>IT Security</u> & <u>GDPR</u> guidance
- Save your work in a folder on your school or unit's Shared Drive in Google Drive
- 4. Share a Google Drive link, rather than send an attachment
- 5. If you like the folder structure on your desktop, try <u>Google Drive</u> <u>for Desktop</u> as a virtual G drive



## Google Drive for Desktop



- Sets up a virtual G drive on your computer
- Granting access to Shared Drives, etc. must still be done on the web version of Google Drive
- Lets you continue using Word, Excel, PowerPoint on files created in those formats, stored on Google Drive
- Download and install it from the settings icon in the top-right of your web Google Drive
