Grenoble: Study in **France** at *Université Grenoble Alpes*. If you are interested in territorial planning and development, the environment, geomatics, and urban planning, as well as in research on territories, their surroundings, and their evolution the Institute of Urban Planning and Alpine Geography (IUGA) with more than 800 students and 50 lecturers is the right place for you. Teaching is in French.

Barcelona: Study in **Spain** in Catalonia's capital at *Universitat de Barcelona*. The faculty of history and geography is situated in the heart of the city. It brings together research and teaching in social and cultural anthropology, archaeology, geography, history, and history of art. The geography department provides modules ranging from land planning and management, its conservation and administration, to the relations between society and the physical environment. Teaching is in Spanish.

Hamburg: Study in one of **Germany's** biggest cities, located in North Germany crossed by hundreds of canals and the rivers Elbe and Alster, famous for St. Pauli and Schanzenviertel. The Institute of Geography specializes in climate, urban and resource geography but offers a range of modules from physical to human geography and Integrative Environmental Geography. Among the seminars offered in English are GIS, Responses to extreme events and disasters, Biodiversity in Earth's History, Political Ecology, Ecozones of the Earth, and many more courses in German.

Cologne: Study in North-Rhine Westfalia's biggest city with a population just over 1 million. Famous for its cathedral, beer, and location next to the river Rhine. *Cologne University* offers a range of geography modules at the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences. Have your pick of modules in GIS, Urban and Economic Geography, Coastal Morphology, Global South, Climatology, Geomorphology and many more. Teaching in English and German.

Göteborg: Study in **Sweden's** second-largest city at *University of Gotenburg's* Department of Economy and Society. With a focus on Human Geography, modules are offered on topics such as Development geography; Mobility, communication, and transport geography; nature-society in a landscape perspective, and GIS. Teaching is primarily in English.

Stockholm: Study in the capital of **Sweden**. *Universitet Stockholm's* Department of Geography offers English modules in both Human and **Physical Geography**: Challenges for Planning in the Global South, Gender and Geography, Place, Identity and Migration, Swedish Geography, GIS and Spatial Analysis, Urban and Regional Planning, Cities and Urban Society, Population, Environment and Landscape Change, Glaciers and High Mountain Environment, Climate Variability, Earth Science, Geomorphological Processes.
