Summer Program For High School Students

The UCD High School Summer Program is an enrichment program designed for North American students especially interested in learning more about Irish history, culture and student life. Through taught lectures and field trips, students will become acquainted with Ireland's rich cultural heritage and the vibrant capital city of Dublin.

The program will also highlight UCD's unique degree programs and prepare students for the exciting and rewarding experience of studying in Ireland on a more long-term basis.

Summer Program

Key Features:

- Taught lectures and field trips to learn about and engage with Irish history and culture
- Faculty-led workshops to learn about different degree options, including UCD Colleges of Business, Science, Engineering & Architecture, Social Science & Law, Arts & Humanities and more
- Application workshop led by UCD North America admission counselors
- Opportunities to meet one-on-one with UCD degree program representatives to discuss specific courses of study
- Introduction to UCD's student supports, clubs and societies
- Accommodation in UCD's on-campus student residences

Admissions criteria

To be eligible for admissions to the UCD High School Summer Program, students must be 16 or 17 years old during the program dates and resident in the United States or Canada. Students must also present the following

- GPA of 3.0 or higher (unweighted)
- Counselor/teacher
 recommendation
- Essay detailing interest in studying in Ireland/UCD

Application Deadlines

November 1 Applications Open February 15 Priority Deadline

April 1 Applications Close

Priority deadline application review begins February 15 and initial decisions will be released March 1. Any applications submitted after the Priority Deadline will be reviewed on a rolling basis, pending availability, and will take up to four weeks to process. Applicants going into senior year will be prioritized for places on the program.

Fees

The inclusive cost of the program is €3100 Euro (approx. \$3400 as of Aug. 2023) This fee includes:

- Airport pick-ups and drop offs
- Academic lectures and workshops
- On-campus housing
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day
- Field trips
