

# **University of Glasgow Summer School**



## **Programme details:**

#### Scottish Cultural Landscapes: Nation, Heritage and the Arts, from 17 June to 13 July 2020

This summer school will give students across all disciplines a unique perspective on contemporary cultural practices with an analysis of their historical, cultural and socio-economic roots. Alongside the academic programme, excursions and social activities will create a true Scottish experience. The course is specifically designed for an international audience, allowing students to explore the local cultural context as the primary case study and compare it to the variety of their own cultural and disciplinary contexts.

#### **Eligibility:**

Undergraduate students who have completed Stage 2 by 1 June 2020 and masters students. This course is open to students from all disciplines.

### **Estimated cost of participation:**

Tuition fees: £1995 (approximately **€2,395** - this fee includes an exclusive 25% U21 discount.) The course

fee includes: tuition, orientation pack and welcome event, Scottish cultural immersion programme, trips around Scotland, social events, Scottish ceilidh, airport pick-up on 17 June

from 7 am to 7 pm)

Housing: £479.04 (approximately **€575**)

Other expenses: While in Glasgow, students will be responsible for the cost of transportation, food and

personal expenses. Please refer to this website for an estimate of living costs in Glasgow.

#### **UCD** scholarship:

UCD is offering one travel grant worth €3,150 as a contribution towards participation in the summer school. The grant includes:

- €2,395 towards tuition fees
- €575 towards accommodation
- €180 towards flights

## **Application process:**

Students must be nominated by their home institution to take part in this course. The deadline to apply to be nominated by UCD and to receive the scholarship is **Wednesday**, **11 March at 13:00**. All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their scholarship application on Friday, 20 March. Students who have not been awarded the UCD scholarship but who would still like to be nominated for this summer programme will have the opportunity to do so, however attendance will not be financially sponsored by UCD.

## **Selection criteria:**

Applicants will be assessed on their academic progress and on the quality of their personal statement.
