Programme details:

EUROPE INSIDE OUT: A 2020 SUMMER SCHOOL UNLIKE ANY OTHER – Monday, 29 June to Friday, 10 July 2020

During this 14-day residential course jointly offered by the Faculties of Arts, Economics & Business and Social Sciences, students combine two majors, chosen from a list of four:

- Doing Business with Europe(ans);
- Policies & Politics in the EU;
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation in Europe
- Social & Cultural Interactions.

Eligibility:

Undergraduate students enrolled in Stage 3 or 4 at the time of application and masters students. Please refer to KU Leuven's website for further information on eligibility.

Estimated cost of participation:

Tuition fees:	€600 (reduced fee for students from affiliated institutions - includes tuition, social and cultural events and reading materials)
Housing:	€650 in Residences Sedes (limited number of rooms available)
Other expenses:	While in Leuven, students will be responsible for the cost of transportation, food and personal expenses. Please refer to this website for an estimate of living costs in Leuven .

UCD scholarship:

UCD is offering two travel grants worth €1,525 each as a contribution towards participation in the summer school. The grant includes:

- €600 towards tuition fees
- €650 towards accommodation
- €275 towards flights

Application process:

Students must apply for the UCD scholarship before applying to KU Leuven. The deadline to apply for a UCD Scholarship is **Wednesday, 11 March at 13:00**. All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their scholarship application on Friday, 20 March. Students who have not been awarded the UCD scholarship but who would still like to register for this summer programme can apply directly to KU Leuven, however attendance will not be financially sponsored by UCD.

Selection criteria:

Applicants will be assessed on their academic progress and on the quality of their personal statement.
