Programme details:

[How Switzerland got rich](#), from 5 to 24 July 2020

This summer school looks at the development of Switzerland into one of the richest and most globalised countries in the world. Participating in this summer school will not only allow students to get to know the University of Zurich but also to experience Zurich as one of the world's most attractive student cities. As part of the social programme, students will be introduced to some of the most beautiful spots in the city and the region and will have plenty of opportunities to socialise and make friends.

Eligibility:

Undergraduate students who have completed Stage 2 by 1 June 2020 and masters students. This course is open to students from all disciplines. Please see the University of Zurich's website for further information on eligibility criteria.

Estimated cost of participation:

Tuition fees:	The regular course fee is 2,000 Swiss Francs (~€1,980) but the University of Zurich is offering one UCD student a discounted rate of 1,000 Swiss Francs (~€940)
Housing:	Between 1,000 Swiss Francs (~€940) to 1,680 Swiss Francs (~€1,580) for the duration of the summer school if the student books their accommodation through the University of Zurich (limited places available)
Other expenses:	While in Zurich, students will be responsible for the cost of transportation, food and personal expenses. Please refer to this website for an estimate of living costs in Zurich .

UCD scholarship:

UCD is offering one travel grant worth **€2,155** as a contribution towards participation in the summer school. The grant includes:

- €940 towards tuition fees
- €940 towards accommodation
- €275 towards flights

Application process:

Students must apply for the UCD scholarship before applying to the University of Switzerland. The deadline to apply for a UCD Scholarship is **Wednesday, 11 March at 13:00**. All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their scholarship application on Friday, 20 March. Students who have not been awarded the UCD scholarship but who would still like to register for this summer programme can apply directly to the University of Zurich, however attendance will not be financially sponsored by UCD.

Selection criteria:

Applicants will be assessed on their academic progress and on the quality of their personal statement.
