

UCD Academic Council Committee on Student Conduct and Capacity Summary of meeting 26 April 2023

- 1. ACCSCC approved the Minutes of its meeting held on 14 December 2022.
- 2. ACCSCC approved the Summary Note of its meeting held on 14 December 2022.
- 3. ACCSCC approved updates to the following student fitness to practise statements:
 - a) School of Education
 - Professional Master of Education
 - MSc Mathematics and Science Education
 - b) School of Mathematics and Statistics
 - BSc Science, Mathematics and Education
 - c) School of Public Health, Physiotherapy and Sports Science
 - BSc Physiotherapy
 - Professional Masters in Physiotherapy
 - MSc Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics

The updated statements will be operational from the next academic session.

- 4. ACCSCC approved clarification submitted from Academic Council Committee on Examinations (ACCE) with regard to grade changes resulting from the student disciplinary process.
- 5. ACCSCC endorsed the proposed revisions to the Student Discipline Procedure 2023/24 and recommended them to ACEC for approval. These updates arose from learning from case practice during the academic session 2022/23 and they are intended to improve clarify of the procedure for staff and students, and they relate to sections: 1 (Student Rights and Responsibilities), 5.12 (Student Conduct Meeting), 5.1 (Student Conduct Meeting), 6.2 (Procedures of the Student Disciplinary Committee), and 5.5c (Student Conduct Meeting).
- 6. ACCSCC endorsed membership of the sub-panel of the Student Conduct Panel for a three-year term 2023/24 2025/26 and recommended its approval to ACEC. This sub-panel will hear cases that have been referred to the Student Discipline Procedure following an external investigation under the Dignity and Respect policy and it will be operational from 2023/24 academic session.
