The winner will be announced in the week commencing 20 January 2025.



The next coffee morning will be held on Thurs 20 November in the Red Room, Student Centre from 10.30 – 11.30am.


Student Coffee morning provides a great opportunity for students to meet with other graduate research students, share experiences and insights, make new connections and enjoy a chat over a coffee.


Launch of new student arts magazine - The Secret Lake
